Board Policy

The Board endorses the following goals for the CSUS:

- 1. The System assures the structural and financial sustainability of its constituent institutions for the fulfillment of their assigned missions while assisting them to maximize their state-wide contributions toward building a stronger future for Colorado and its people.
- 2. The System exists to support, enhance, foster, and protect the unique missions and integrity of its constituent institutions working individually and collaboratively to serve the students and the people of Colorado.
